 - Bydd yn rhaid i'r cystadleuwyr lenwi ffurflen a ddarperir i nodi manylion eu gweithgareddau gyda'r CFFI a'i chyflwyno i Swyddfa'r Sir erbyn 26ain Ionawr 2011 (dylid rhoi pwyslais arbennig ar eu cyfraniad ar lefel Clwb).
 - Cyfwelir y cystadleuwyr gan banel o feirniaid mewn awyrgylch anffurfiol.
- AMCANION.**

Amcan y gystadleuaeth yw dewis aelod sydd wedi dangos ei fod ef/hi yn cyfrannu tuag at bob agwedd o Fudiad CFFI. Bydd y beirniaid yn chwilio am:-

 - Gyfraniad tuag at weithgareddau'r Clwb ei hun tra'n aelod ohono
 - Cyfraniad tuag at CFFI yn gyffredinol (hy. Clwb, Sir, Cymru neu Genedlaethol).
 - Cyfraniad tuag at weithgareddau penodol dros y 12 mis diwethaf (cadwraeth, cystadlaethau, recriwtio, trefnu rhaglenni, elusennau, chwaraeon, swyddog clwb)
 - Ymrwymiad cyffredinol i CFFI - ymwybyddiaeth o ddiddordeb cyd-aelodau yn CFFI a meddu ar olwg gwrthrychol o ddyfodol y Mudiad.
 - Gwybodaeth am y CFFI ar lefel Clwb, Sir, Rhanbarth a Chenedlaethol
- Mae penderfyniad y Beirniad yn derfynol.

SENIOR MEMBER OF THE YEAR

- ELIGIBILITY** - The competitor shall be 26 years or under on 1st September 2011 and full members of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC.
Competitors will be required to show their Membership Cards. Failure to produce a card will result in a penalty charge. Any member whose name is not listed as a current paid up member of the Federation and who cannot produce a membership card at the start of the competition will **not** be allowed to compete.
- HEALTH AND SAFETY** – All Competitions carried out at County level must comply with Health and Safety legislation and meet the relevant safety standards. The completion of a Parental Consent form, for members under the age of 18, is the responsibility of the Club and must be submitted to County Office with membership details.
- PROCEDURE**
 - Competitors will be required to complete a form provided which will show details of their YFC activities and submit to the Carms YFC Office by 26th January 2011.
 - Competitors will be interviewed by a panel of judges in an informal atmosphere.
- OBJECTIVES** - The objective of the competition is to select a member who has shown that they are involved in all aspects of the YFC Movement. Judges will be looking for:-
 - Involvement at club level for period of membership
 - Overall YFC involvement (ie. Club, County, Wales or National).
 - Specific involvement in activities in previous 12 months (conservation, competitions, recruitment, programming, charity, sport, club officer)
 - General commitment to YFC - awareness of fellow members' interests in YFC and objective view of the future of the Movement.
 - Knowledge of the YFC at Club, County, Area and National levels
- The Judge's decision is final.
- Carms YFC reserve the right to amend or cancel any of the foregoing rules.

JUNIOR MEMBER OF THE YEAR

1. **ELIGIBILITY** – The competitor shall be 17 years or under on 1st September 2011 and full members of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC. Competitors will be required to show their Membership Cards. Failure to produce a card will result in a penalty charge. Any member whose name is not listed as a current paid up member of the Federation and who cannot produce a membership card at the start of the competition will not be allowed to compete.
2. **HEALTH AND SAFETY** – All Competitions carried out at County level must comply with Health and Safety legislation and meet the relevant safety standards. The completion of a Parental Consent form, for members under the age of 18, is the responsibility of the Club and must be submitted to County Office with membership details.
3. **PROCEDURE- PART 1 – CURRICULUM VITAE (CV)**
Competitors are requested to submit a CV not to exceed two sides of A4 with the following information: Competitors are to design and present the CV in their own style.
Name, address, YFC Club and County Federation
Personal Profile (Background) information
Qualifications or Awards
Activities within YFC over previous 12 months
School/career aspirations
Activities outside YFC

Leadership, Teamwork, Charity/Voluntary Work, Skills

PART 3 – PRESENTATION & FORMAL INTERVIEW

Competitors are requested to prepare a presentation using Microsoft power point software to include the competitors experiences gained at YFC Club, County and including activities outside of YFC. The presentation should be based on experiences gained in the last 12 months (February to February) .

This presentation is to compliment your CV and the Experience, Skills and Attributes Form.

Timing – no less than 3 and no more than 5 minutes.

The presentation will be made to the judges.

On completion of the presentation judges will ask questions on the CV and Experience, Skills and Attributes Form, on the competitors knowledge of YFC and/or current issues or news relating to young people.
