- 2 Download an application form from the website or contact your County Office. Your County Office is required to sign the form before submitting to NFYFC.
- 3 Send the completed form to [lauren.hancox@nfyfc.org.uk](mailto:lauren.hancox@nfyfc.org.uk) before the closing date of 1st November 2019.
- 4 All successful applicants are required to attend the YFC Selection Day in person on 30 November 2019. There will be no Skype interviews this year.

## Need to know info!

- With the exception of C Alma Baker, all visas (if required), flights, insurance and travel vaccinations (if required) are at the member's own cost and are the responsibility of the members. Members will also need to cover the cost of their social expenditure on each trip. Local bursaries may be available, contact your County Office for more info.
- Members are only able to participate in three Homestay trips. This does not include C Alma Baker, RYE or team travel.
- The Canada 4H trip must be taken after the YFC member has hosted a Canadian exchangee for 1-2 weeks in the UK. You will stay with the same member during the whole of your stay in Canada.
- C Alma Baker trip to New Zealand allows for one month free time after the three months
- Members must be able to travel on the date specified by the host country/state and these may be subject to change.
- For trips that take two or more exchangees, the members selected are advised to liaise and coordinate travel with one another.
- If you are applying for a trip with a stay of over two weeks long, please ensure you have permission from your employer to have the minimum time off as stated for each trip
- A percentage of the travel costs for the Rural Youth Europe trips could be reimbursed - depending on RYE funding.
- Should a trip(s) receive a high volume of applications, NFYFC reserves the right to shortlist members for selection day.
- The Scotland, Northern Ireland and RYE trips are only available to YFC members holding membership with an English county; Wales are able to send their own delegates.

# Need help choosing a destination?

With 14 locations to choose from, there really is something for everyone among the YFC holidays available in 2020. From working in New Zealand to volunteering in Vietnam, Peru or Ghana, YFC Travel has so much to offer members who want to pack up and get away!

Choose from the following types of trip and send in your application form before 1 November.

## **Homestays**

Stay with host families in a rural location or on a farm and really experience the life in a different part of the world. It's a great way to make friends for life and really get to grips with another culture. You could stay with families in, Australia, Canada, USA, Scotland or Northern Ireland.

## **Working Scholarship: New Zealand**

Apply for one of four scholarships through the C Alma Baker Trust Travel Award. Available only to YFC members with agricultural experience, they provide an opportunity to work on a beautiful sheep, beef and dairy farm on the North Island's west coast.

## **Rural Youth Europe's Seminars**

Travel as part of a team of two to Strasbourg or Ireland. Take part in Rural Youth Europe's (RYE) spring or autumn seminars, which are great fun, and you'll get to meet people from similar organisations across Europe. Perfect for people who can only take a short time off from work or studies.

## **Rural Youth Europe's European Rally**

The European Rally 202 is being hosted in Slovenia and you could be joining 150 other young farmers from all over Europe for a week of workshops, sightseeing and learning about other European cultures.

## **Volunteering – Vietnam, Peru and Ghana**

There are three amazing locations to choose from in 2020. Each trip has been tailored by Projects Abroad for YFC members to live and work together. In Peru you could be working with schoolchildren and developing a vegetable garden. In Vietnam you will work alongside local farmers to understand traditional farming methods, while in Ghana you'll be on a small farm helping to develop sustainable farming methods.
